CHILI TEAM APPLICATION

1. Entry fee is \$45 per team. No refunds. Deadline for applications is March 24th -SD Health Dept. needs paperwork 1 month from event. Certified checks, business checks or money orders payable to BBPA will be accepted. **Cash Prizes: \$500-1st Place, \$300-2nd Place, \$200-3rd Place. Everyone can vote for their favorite team – "People's Choice"- \$100.00 and "Best Decorated Booth"- \$100.**
2. Set-up and food prep is 6am. Chili ingredients must be prepared on site of event per the San Diego County Health Department and not in home kitchen. Save time, buy chopped garlic, frozen chopped onions and if using beans, purchase large cans (Costco/Market).
3. **The Health Department is helping team costs by "waiving" the health permit fee.**
4. Someone on your team must have a Food Handler's Card and have it with them at event.
Free Food Handler's Card classes: Tuesday, March 2, 6:00pm at the Bonita-Sunnyside Library Classroom, 4375 Bonita Road & Wednesday, March 10, 5:30pm at the Bonita Golf Club.
5. Please cook a minimum of 5-7 gallons ready for public-11am (judging cup in team kit)
6. Bring your ingredients, supplies, food handlers gloves, pot, portable propane stove/grill. You must have a **Temporary Handwashing Station** in your booth (see enclosed diagram). Teams will be assigned to designated sinks on site for utensil washing. Map with space # will be mailed to you.
7. All vehicles must be removed from the site 8:45am. Parking available at local shopping centers on Bonita Road, no parking available at golf course.)
8. All displays, booth decorations must be suitable for our family event.
9. Tasting and general public will begin at 11am and will end at 3pm. **Chili sampling only to adults and children with wristbands.**
10. Sample cups will be picked up at approximately 12:30, judged by # only.
11. Tasting cups, cup for judging, plastic spoons, paper napkins and voting box will be provided in a "kit" that you pick-up at the Information Booth (just send someone over from your team)
12. Booth space clean-up is responsibility of the participant. Please bring a 30-40 gallon plastic trash can. Large bins and recycling boxes provided by Edco.
